



Preparing For Your Shoot

You need to bring your own clothes, a good variety

POSSIBLE SETS TO SHOOT:

- Portfolio Headshots
- High Fashion / Catwalk look
- Advertising / Lifestyle campaign look
- Outdoors: fashion & lifestyle
- FHM glamour look
- Glamour or Art Nude

We will shoot whatever you need, if you have specific requirements at any level, then please just let us know. We do not have to shoot all the categories above and can shoot other variations according to your needs.

WHAT TO BRING FOR YOUR SHOOT:

Evening wear, elegant dress, maybe suitable for wedding.

Club wear, as you would for going out clubbing.

Fashion wear, whatever you have that is current, fashionable, interesting.

Underwear, both lacy and simple, plain black or plain white
Make sure you have a strapless bra.

Stockings and/or tights.

Shoes to match all combinations.

Try to avoid fussy colours and patterns, simple colours are best

If we are shooting outdoors, then bring a nice coat.
The ground can be muddy in places, bring shoes you don't mind getting dirty.

If you have any special clothes that are either very distinctive, interesting or you would like in your 'folio please bring them along.

Better to bring more and not use it, than bring too little!



WHAT MAKE-UP:

Your shoot will have a mix of fairly light make-up and serious fashion magazine make-up

You need strong colours for this, very bright.

Bring whatever you need for your hair.

If you have booked a make-up artist, then please come without make-up,

WHAT ELSE?

For fun and keeping you going, bring:

- Something to eat and drink (especially drink)
- Music
- Your mobile
- Suitable accessories for your clothes
- Any photos that you've seen that you really like.

BEFORE YOU ARRIVE:

Make sure you have slept well and have a good breakfast.

Do not wear any underwear before you arrive, this can leave marks on your skin which take forever to relax away.

Best to leave your jewellery at home, except for that which you need as accessories

If you have not booked a make-up artist, then arriving with your make-up done will allow you to make more time for your shoot.



PRACTICAL STUFF:

If you want to bring a friend to help, please do, we welcome it, she knows your look better than we do and can help you out all the way through the session.

We do have private areas for you to get changed in. We have mirrors for make-up and the like. However, we don't provide makeup at all. You must bring your own. If you have booked a make-up artist, they will bring make-up

Depending on what you want, we may also use various cloth drapes and so on, these are usually held on by you and a judicious clothes peg or two!

SOME THINGS TO BRING:

Music (CD's or MP3 player)

Pictures you like

Hairbrush! (all girls seem to forget this!) and hair bands/clips

Personal props

Jewellery & Accessories (keep it simple)

Make-up Kit

Map & Phone Number
